Provided technical support to 41 AU Member States, including Djibouti, to prepare progress reports on Agenda 2063.

Multimodal transport connectivity for economic development

Preparations of the feasibility study on the trans-Maghreb highway commenced.

Virtual PIDA information centre

Data collection on PIDA commenced in five countries, including Mauritania, in the UMA region. Furthermore, regional and national-level strategies were defined to improve data collection processes. Support was provided in strengthening capacity of UMA to monitor infrastructure development in the region.

Policy and regulatory frameworks for PIDA projects

- » 21 countries including Mauritania were trained on water governance and international law with regards to transboundary waters in Africa.
- » The status of cyber security was assessed in 13 countries including Mauritania.

Home Grown School Feeding

Fight against malnutrition in schools through community-driven nutrition driven food supply. 15 countries including Mauritania are implementing the Home Grown School Feeding Programme.

Initiative for Food and Nutrition Security in Africa (IFNA)

- » Strengthening maternal and child feeding.
- » 12 participating countries, including Mauritania, have finalised and validated national nutrition action plans.
