- 1. ARSO founded 1977 by OAU (currently AU)
- 2. Abuja Treaty of 1991 Chapter XI Article 67: adopt a common policy on standardization and quality assurance of goods and services among Member States;
- 3. AU CAMI, 20th Ordinary Session, 10–14 June 2013: Recognize the PAQI(ARSO, AFSEC, AFRAC, AFRIMETS) as the continental platform for all matters related to standardization, metrology, accreditation and conformity assessment

- ✓ Quality policy finalized- under approval of AUC organs
- ✓ Technical regulation framework ongoing
- ✓ Made in Africa guideline ongoing


- 2. State Parties shall:

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

Collaboration-Institution framework


Shrimp- supply chain




